Nevada's 76th Session of Grand Assembly, International Order of the Rainbow for Girls, will be held in Reno beginning with FUN Night on Saturday, June 19th through Tuesday, June 22nd, 2010. We hope you will join us for our "Let Beijing Be Our Temple of Peace" sessions.

TRANSPORTATION

If you are flying, RENO is your flight destination. The Reno International Airport is approximately two miles from the Circus Circus Hotel/Casino where housing and all events are scheduled. For adults, renting a car is probably a wise decision as there are many exciting and fun things to do and see in the Reno area during your "free" time (Tuesday afternoon). The Hotel does run a hotel shuttle from the airport to the Hotel.

As guests of Nevada Grand Assembly, please note our first session on Sunday is scheduled from 3 pm until approximately 8 pm; you will want to be sure to have a substantial late lunch before this session starts! A light BOXED dinner will be available this year through our registration packet meant to be taken to your hotel rooms for a casual, satisfying and healthy late dinner. On Tuesday, you will have free time from approximately noon until 5 pm when Installation begins. Gentlemen: business attire.

(Please note: Those attending Vespers and Grand Cross move immediately from one venue to the next; the same attire is appropriate at both.)

Sunday, Monday and Tuesday

Rainbow Girls and female Advisory Board Members: formal attire;

Gentlemen: business or formal attire;

Women may wear street length dresses if they are not to be escorted.
