



Dear Mother Advisors & Grand Deputies:

Rainbow Camp is just around the corner! As last year I will require some firm commitments from the adults attending, as I am planning an Alzheimer's event that should be fun and give all attending the opportunity to earn service hours.

In the spirit of this years' theme, "Girls Just Wanna Have Fun", everyone is encouraged to wear "Rainbow Appropriate" pajamas, but the Alzheimer's event will be outside, so please ensure that everyone wears proper walking shoes and has the appropriate coat, hat and gloves when attending camp. As always, I will have a back-up plan for our unpredictable weather. When the girls merge into their afternoon groups I will assign specific adults to each group who will be responsible for the girls in those groups regardless of the activity that is taking place. Sometime during the morning activities with the GWAA, I will meet with all of the adults to go over the afternoon activities.

As normal, I will be assigning shifts in the kitchen and will try to ensure that there are no conflicts with those assemblies that have other responsibilities.

Attached are the registration form and the camp flyer. It is very important that I have **everyone's first and last name, as the hotels require both**, and we need the girl's names for their badges along with their age.

Groups will be divided up prior to camp and each camper will receive a name-badge indicating which group she will belong to. Please stress to your girls how important it is to stay in the group they are assigned during the morning and the afternoon activities. The adults assigned to oversee the afternoon groups will have a list of each girl in their group and will need to keep track of them during the afternoon.

Please tell your Grand Officers they need to be at the Convention Center no later than 7:15 AM. They will meet with Jessica and be briefed on their responsibilities as Group Leaders.

Rainbow Camp 2010 will kick off right after breakfast which begins at 8:00 am on Saturday March 13, 2010, led by our

Grand Worthy Associate Advisor, Jessica. Meals on Saturday, and Breakfast on Sunday are provided, all of which will be at the Convention Center. Saturday night entertainment will begin at 7:30 PM, organized by the Grand Flag Bearers.

There will be group activities in the morning and afternoon, and Proficiency and Grand Choir Practice after lunch as well.

Grand Charity's Sweet Shop will also open during the lunch hour. So, as in the past, each Assembly please plan to make donations to the Sweet Shop.

As last year, we will celebrate Rainbow Sunday, please dress accordingly.

The cost of camp is \$60.00 for each person and \$10.00 for each pledge member attending camp. The price covers meals, supplies and hotel. Please make **one check** for your Assembly payable to Nevada Grand Assembly. 50% of the registration fee will be refunded if cancellations are made prior to February 26, 2010, after that date there will be no refunds made.

Hotel check-in is prior to midnight on Friday, March 12, 2010. Once you have registered I will contact each assembly as to which hotel you will be staying. **IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT REGISTRATION AND MONEY BE IN BY THE DEADLINE.**
